WHEN: March 19-21, 2010

WHERE: Camp Barstow, Batesburg, SC (near Columbia)

WHY: All Catholic Boy Scouts, Venture Scouts and Scouters within the Province of Atlanta come together for fun and fellowship and to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of the Boy Scouts of America and the 100th Anniversary of their Duty to God.

Come and join your fellow Scouts and Scouters for a great weekend and the **cost is just right-- \$40** which **includes four (4) meals, cracker barrel, a patch and a t-shirt**. **There will be a second patch that may be earned during the weekend**. Adirondacks are available in campsites on a first come first serve basis (**bring tents just in case**). The weekend starts off on **Friday night** with a **concert**. **Saturday's activities** include: **Craftsman Track** (Super Pioneering, Rope Trails, etc.); **Scout Spirit Track** (Stairway to Heaven, Duty to Country, Duty to God, Scout Museum, etc.); **Challenge Track** (Rifle shooting, shotgun shooting, archery, war canoes, climbing tower, etc.); **Vendor Track** (Red Cross conducting blood drive, etc.). **Mass will be celebrated Saturday evening with all the bishops and priests in attendance (same as National Scout Jamboree Mass)**. **Sunday** will see the **Closing Ceremonies**.

While there is no program that weekend for Cub Scouts, **Packs are invited to register to attend the Saturday evening Mass and for \$8 will receive a patch and t-shirt**. They will have to handle their own food and find local campsites if they wish to camp that weekend (camping space is limited at Camp Barstow). Information can also be provided about programs in the area they can visit.
